



The current threat environment and reporting cybercrime in Australia

The Manager of ACIC Cybercrime Intelligence will be presenting on the agency, its role within the ACSC and how it contributes to combating cybercrime in Australia. The presentation will give an overview of the cybercrime landscape in Australia including information on current threats such as: Financially motivated ransomware, Credential harvesting malware including banking Trojans that specifically target Australia, Business email compromise, Distributed denial of service for extortion, The rise of cryptojacking, Targeting of third party providers as a means to access customer networks and data. The impact of cybercrime on Australia will also be discussed, with reference to the Australian Cybercrime Online Reporting Network (ACORN) and the patterns and trends in reporting seen across 2017-2018.
